- **Certified Mental Performance Consultant®** - Strong continued growth in the number of active CMPCs. Surpassed milestone - currently 1,025 total. Our primary org focus.
- **Graduate Program Accreditation** - New accreditation standards for graduate programs in sport and performance psychology (2023), program launch (2025), first accreditation decisions expected in 2026. Helps to ensure competencies for effective performance.
