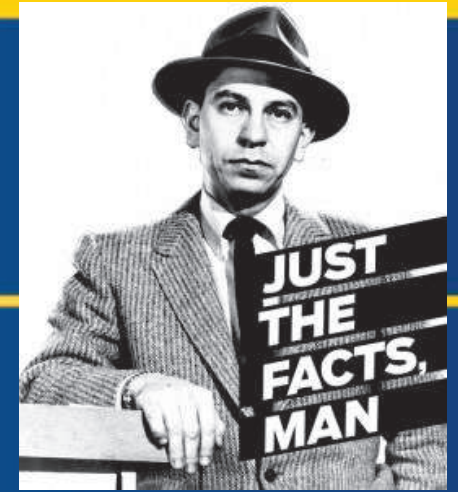


Organizational Update: AAPSM

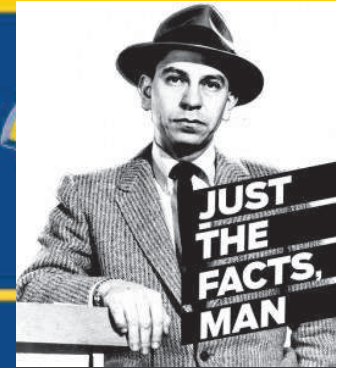

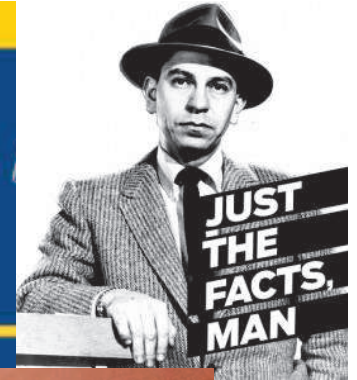
